Shareholder Oppression Claim Settles For \$3.1 Million

The plaintiffs in this matter were shareholders in several different family businesses including a real estate holding company and various operating entities. After the plaintiffs learned that the defendants had been using profits from jointly-owned companies to prop up their own separately-owned entity, the plaintiffs retained counsel and prepared to file suit alleging, interalia, shareholder oppression, breach of fiduciary duties, disgorgement of monies improperly diverted by corporate directors, unjust enrichment, and a request for a detailed accounting at the putative defendants' expense. In an attempt to avoid costly and protracted litigation, the parties spent many months negotiating to try and resolve their dispute, and ultimately agreed to participate in a formal pre-suit mediation under the guidance of a neutral third party. At the close of a protracted and contentious mediation, the parties reached an agreement in principle, but ended up in binding arbitration after the defendants refused to sign settlement agreements. Midway through the arbitration, the defendants relented and signed agreements to redeem all of the plaintiffs' shares in all of the jointly-owned companies in exchange for a significant cash payment, the transfer of various properties to the plaintiffs, and several years of guaranteed lease revenue.
